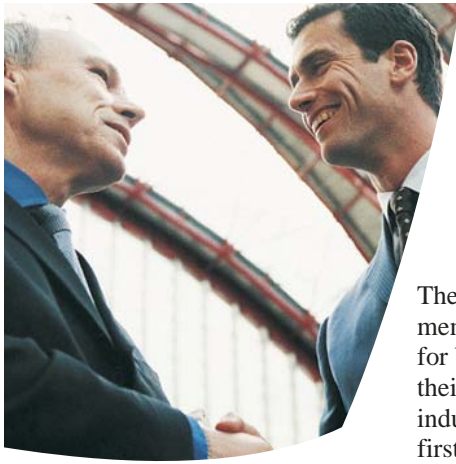

The first nominee (as determined by your company) will be automatically accepted in to the FLF. Nominees will be sent an application after their nomination is received. All nominees, including the first nominee, must complete and return their application. When the completed applications are received, each firm's first submittal will be notified of their official membership. The remaining two nominees will then be placed in a pool with

other candidates to fill any remaining positions. Based on the applications and personal interviews, the FLF Steering Committee will make a decision on who will fill the remaining positions.
