When the completed applications are received, each firm's first submittal will be notified of their official membership. The remaining two nominees will then be placed in a pool with

other candidates to fill any remaining positions. Based on the applications and personal interviews, the FLF Steering Committee will make a decision on who will fill the remaining positions.
